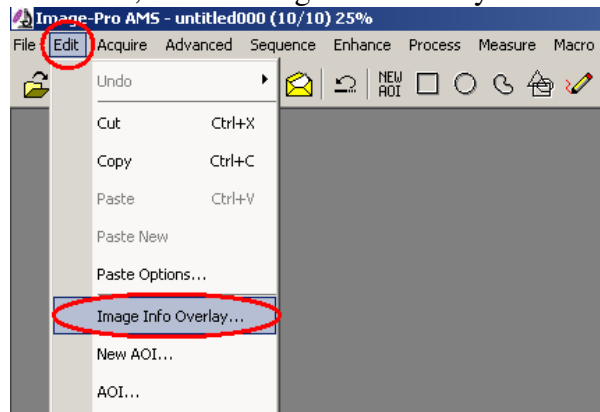



Using Image Info Overlay in Image Pro Plus v 6.2 and higher.

You can use the “Image Info Overlay” feature to display information on top of an image or sequence. This information is updated for each frame in a sequence so is particularly useful for Z acquisitions, timelapse acquisitions or other multi-plane acquisitions where metadata needs to be displayed to the viewer.

1. Open an image or a sequence into Image Pro.
2. Under the Edit Menu, select “Image Info overlay”



3. With the overlay Window open you may select what information to display on the image, as well as whether to enable or disable the overlay.



Applies the display to the image

Stamps the overlay when the image is printed.

In order for the layer to become a part of the image (to overwrite the image data) you need to apply the overlay to a new image.

*****If this step is not completed the overlay will not appear on exported images**
